THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST, SECULAR DEMOCRATIC, REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens: JUSTICE, social, economic and political LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief faith and worship; EQUALITY of status and of opportunity: and to promote among them all, FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation. IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA Chapter IV A FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

ARTICLE 51 A

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

(a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideas and institutions, the National Flag and the NationalAnthem;

- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom.
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and so abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all sphere of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

Admission

Admission to the school is mainly in the LKG. Admission to other classes depends on vacancies that arise due to withdrawals. A child seeking admission in LKG should have completed 4 years on or before 1st of June of the academic year. Every student should produce the Birth Certificate or the Transfer Certificate depending on the classes to which they are admitted. All students seeking admission should be staying with their parents or guardians.

Evaluation

Further, the following general guidelines on Assessment and Promotion Policy for classes KG to IX and XI may be noted for the smooth conduct of assessment for the session 2025-26

- Multi-disciplinary Projects (MDP) for classes III to VIII will continue to assess holistic learning of the students. Only one MDP is required to be assigned per term for all subjects. However, in order to cover all subjects if there is need, additional MDP may be assigned.
- 2. The qualifying marks for class IX students shall be 33% in each subject. This implies that the student is expected to score 33% including both Annual examination (80) and Internal Assessment (20) taken together. However, overall 33% marks is also required to promote the student in the next higher class. For class IX students offering 5 subjects and failing in two of the five subjects shall be placed in compartment in those subjects. And if any student failing in more than 02 subjects shall be treated as 'Essential repeat'.
- 3. The qualifying marks for class XI students shall be 33% in each subject. It is to further clarify that in a subject where Practical/Internal Assessment/Project components are involved; separate pass% (33%) is required in Theory component and Practical/Internal Assessment/Project component. This implies that students need to score 33% out of 70/80 (Theory) and 33% out of 30/20 marks in Practical/Internal Assessment/Project separately. The overall 33% marks are also required for the promotion of the students in next higher class. Students failing in one of the five main subjects in Class XI will be placed under Compartment in that subject and students failing in more than one subject will be treated as 'Essential Repeat'.
- 4. In class-XI, Students need to secure 33% in the supplementary examination (Theory only) to get qualify for the next higher class where as in class-IX, the marks obtained in Annual examination will be substituted by the marks in Supplementary examination to decide the qualifying criteria.
- Students of classes I to X have to do at least one Art-Integrated Project work in each subject as a part of Subject Enrichment Activities which should be of trans-disciplinary nature. The details of the Project are to be submitted through KALASETU portal of CBSE.
- 6. The date of declaration of results for the Session Ending Examination for Academic Year 2025-26 will be 6TH APRIL 2026

Rewards Merit Award details are given below: Std X (1) Full A grade holders of SSE (2) First, second and third position of SSE in the school. (3) Subject Toppers of SSE Std XII (1) Full A grade holders of SSCE of all streams (2) First, second and third position of SSCE of all streams. (3) Subject Toppers of SSCE

Achievers Award

- Std I X 'Aı' in Aggregate in all assessments together up to February with percentile grading (91-100).
- Std XI & XII A score of 80% as aggregate.

NB: (1) The students must be present in all examinations/Assessments

(2) Absence on any grounds will not be considered for exemption. Achievers will be honoured with a certificate and their names will be permanently recorded in the Achievers Record with their signature against their names.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal of a student during a school year is not generally allowed. However, if a student is to be withdrawn for reasons beyond the control of the parent/guardian one calendar month's notice must be given. Transfer certificates will be issued only after all dues are cleared. Application for the TC to be forwarded to the office by the parent (Refer Page no. 119 for the Application form).

Absence in Test papers/Examinations

Absence in examination is not encouraged.

However, absence due to medical reasons should be notified immediately with a leave application supported by a medical certificate from the doctor consulted.

In all cases of absence, the result will be prepared as per the regulative norms. Re-examinations will not be conducted.

Dull brown shorts, reddish pink half sleeve shirt with school monogram, school belt, Dull brown socks with reddish pink lines and black shoes.

Grade V to XII

Dull brown full pants, reddish pink half sleeve shirt with school monogram,

school belt, Dull brown socks with reddish pink lines and black shoes.

GIRLS

LKG to Grade IV

Reddish pink half sleeve shirt ,Dull brown pinafore with school monogram , school belt, Dull brown socks with reddish pink lines and black shoes.

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Grade V to XII

Reddish pink three-forth sleeve shirt, Dull brown pants and collar-free school monogrammed coat which reaches below the buttocks, Dull brown socks with reddish pink lines and black shoes.

Girls should use white hairband, white buns and white muftha or scarf to school.

During rainy days, students are expected to wear ${\color{black}}$ sandals with back ${\color{black}}$ strap.

Students could continue to wear white uniform on Wednesdays with stitching pattern same as regular uniform.

School Transportation

The school provides regular transport facility to enable students to commute to school. Parents can contact the office for any clarification in this regard.

The charges vary according to distance. Transportation fee should be paid in advance for each month. Parents have to make necessary arrangements to hand over and receive their children at scheduled bus points. If school authorities are unable to run buses due to unavoidable circumstances, pupils using school buses have to make their own arrangements.

Library

- 1. Students are expected to take sufficient care of the library books. If a book is lost/damaged, the borrower has to make good the loss/damage along with penalty up to 100% or replace the same book.
- 2. It is strictly forbidden to write any remarks in the book or underline the words. It is the responsibility of the borrower to make sure that nothing of the above nature is contained in the book, and bringing it to the notice of the Librarian immediately on receiving the book.
- 3. Students should not exchange school library books.
- 4. All should see that an atmosphere of silence and solemnness is maintained in the library at all times.
- 5. Books will not be issued during the vacations. At a time, only one book will be issued. A book may be retained only for one week, after which a fine of Rs.10.00 per week will be charged until it is returned or until it is re-issued.
- 6. Pupils from Std V onwards must read atleast 10 English and 10 other language

books in a year. A two page summary of each book read must be shown to the librarian. The library records included in the diary should be maintained scrupulously

House System

To impart a healthy competitive spirit among students and to inculcate the habit of working together and enhancing leadership qualities, an efficient system of 'Houses' has been introduced in the school. All the students belong to one 'House' or the other and are guided by a House Mistress (a teacher) assisted by House Captain, House Vice Captain and house prefects (all students.)

It is the responsibility of the House Mistress to look after the general progress of her wards in curricular and co-curricular activities.

All activities and sports competitions are held in house wise. So house loyalties are the strongest. A regular record of the pupil's participation and achievement in House activities is maintained and merit points are awarded to each House by a team of teachers. Children will be divided into any of the four houses as given below

- 13. Please see that your wards are using only pencils for writing till Std. IV. They are permitted to use fountain pens only from Std. V onwards.
- 14. Please produce a medical certificate along with application for medical leave.
- 15. Please be aware that your ward's name will be struck off if he/she is absent for more than a month without prior intimation.
- 16. Please be aware that for KG children there won't be any formal exams. We shall conduct continuous assessment in the form of worksheets oral and written work.
- 17. Please see that your ward wears the prescribed uniform including foot wear.
- 18. Please buy all text books only from the school store.
- 19. Please encourage that all children should participate in all the academic and co-curricular activites of the school.
- 20. Please be aware that any serious misconduct or objectionable behaviour of your ward will lead to the dismissal from the school.
- 21. Please make good any loss or damage to the school property by the student.
- 22. Please note that the school does not encourage private tuitions.
- 23. Please communicate (requests, suggestions and complaints) only to the Principal/other authorities notified by the Management.
- 24. Please make all request to the Principal at least one week in advance to obtain signatures on travel concession forms, bona fide certificates, reimbursement of fees etc.
- 25. Please give proper identity of the escorts at the school front office to pick up their wards back home from the school. Escorts with proper identity only are allowed to pickup the wards.
- 26. Please go through the diary of the students of the lower classes and assist the children in their learning.
- 27. Please make full use of the free **extra coaching classes** extended to the **academically weak students before/after school** hours and/or on holidays. In such cases they **should make their own arrangements for conveyance**.
