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THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THEPEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST, SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens: JUSTICE, Social, economic and political LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief faith and worship; EQUALITY of status and of opportunity: and to promote among them all, FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation. IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA Chapter IV A

FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

ARTICLE 51 A

Fundamental Duties - it shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

(a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideas and institutions, the National Flag and the NationalAnthem;

- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom.
- (c) to uphold and portect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and so abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all sphere of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

General Information

Vidya Vihar Central School, a CBSE affiliated senior secondary school is situated at Elavally Village in Kakassery near Chittattukara. Kaithapram Damodaran Namboothiri Film Lyric fame inaugurated it on 11th February 2000 in a humble physical set up. The institution is secular in nature. Its progressive strides ever since have many a time won accolades.

Vidya Vihar Central School is uncompromisingly committed to impart quality education and to inculcate all round development in all students. From the small beginning the school has grown into a mighty educational institution giving optimum training and opportunities for all the students. We have classes from LKG to Std. XII. The school is housed in a complex of spacious building at Chittatukara. The campus covers an area of 5 acres. Its serene atmosphere helps the students and teachers to learn in peaceful air. The best thing about this school is that it is situated far away from the hustle and bustle of city life. The scenic beauty, peace and tranquility provide an ideal environment conducive for teaching and learning.

Girls toilets are fitted with incinerator special toilets for CWNS. School and Classrooms are under the surveillance of CCTV.

Co-Curricular Activities

To develop varied interests of the pupils, we provide ample opportunities through several co-curricular activities in addition to games and athletic competitions. Opportunities are provided to learn Dance, Music, Arts & Craft etc. To inculcate a sense of loyalty, team spirit and healthy competition, students are divided into four houses.

Admission

Admission to the school is mainly in the LKG. Admission to other classes depends on vacancies that arise due to withdrawals. A child seeking admission in LKG should be 4 years old on or before 1st of June of the school year.

Every student should produce the birth certificate or the transfer certificate depending on the classes to which they are admitted. All students seeking admission should be staying with their parents or guardians.

Evaluation

For Std. I to Std. X the school follows CBSE guidelines and assessment is based on the academic achievements, subject enrichment activities etc. For LKG-VIII, four PAs and 2 terminal examinations will be conducted, for IX & X three PAs, and mid term and term examination. For XI & XII three PAs, mid term and term examination.

Rewards

Academic Toppers in each year are honoured on Merit day with special awards by the management and PTA. Full A grade holders of SSE and Toppers of SSCE in each stream are considered for this award.

Achievers Award.

- Std I X A score of 'A_1' in Aggregate in all assessments together upto February.
- Std XI & XII A score of 80% as aggregate.
- NB: (1) The students must be present in all examinations/Assessments
 - (2) Absence on any grounds will not be considered for exemption. Achievers will be honoured with a certificate and their names will be permanently recorded in the Achievers Record with their signature against their names.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal of a student during a school year is not generally allowed. However, if a student is to be withdrawn for reasons beyond the control of the parent/guardian one calendar month's notice must be given. Transfer certificates will be issued only after all dues are cleared.

Leave / Absence

A student with continuous absence for 15 days are liable for removal from the register.

Absence in Test papers/Examinations

Absence in examination is not encouraged.

However, absence due to medical reasons should be noticed immediately with a leave application supported by a medical certificate from the doctor consulted. **In all cases of absence, the result will be prepared as per the regulative norms. Re-examinations will not be conducted.**

Grade V to XII

Reddish pink three-forth sleeve shirt, light chiku pants and below waist collarfree coat with school monogram, light chiku socks with reddish pink lines with black shoes.

Girls should use white hairband, white buns and white muftha or scraf to school.

During rainy days, students are preferred to wear **black back strap sandals**. Students could continue to wear white uniform on Wednesdays with stitching pattern same as regular uniform.

Promotion Rules

Promotion of students in grades I to IX & XI is made on the basis of periodic assessments, internal assessments and terminal examination.

80 marks Terminal examination is conducted with 100% syllabus where each student needs to score 33% for a minimum pass. Internal marks are awarded out of 20 marks. Each student has to secure 33% out of overall 20 marks earmarked in each subject. This 20 marks comprises of pen-paper test (5 marks) multiple assessment (5 marks), portfolio (5marks) and subject enrichment activities which includes Assessment of Speaking and Listening (ASL) in languages, practical in Science and Mathematics, Map works and project works in Social Science.

Promotion in grade XI is determined by a minimum of 33% score in each subject, both in theory and practical.

It is mandatory for every student to appear for all the examinations, in order to be eligible for promotion to the next class. A student who does not appear periodic assessment, term examination or annual examination will be considered to have failed except on account of sickness and subject to the direction of the Principal. After each examination, the progress report of the student should be signed by the parent.

Character and discipline of the child is a pre requisite for considering students' promotion to the next classes.

Grade X & XII – Students of grade X and XII attend SSE and SSCE respectively, conducted by the CBSE and the result is declared by the board.

School Transportation

The school provides regular transport facility to enable students to commute to school. Parents can contact the office for any clarification in this regard. The charges vary according to distance. Transportation fee should be paid in advance for each month. Parents have to make necessary arrangements to hand over and receive their children at scheduled bus points. If school authorities are unable to run buses due to unavoidable circumstances, pupils using school buses have to make their own arrangements.

Library

1. Students are expected to take sufficient care of the library books. If a book is lost/damaged, the borrower has to make good the loss/damage along with penalty up to 100%.

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- 2. It is strictly forbidden to write any remarks in the book or underline the words. It is the responsibility of the borrower to make sure that nothing of the above nature is contained in the book, and bringing it to the notice of the Librarian immediately on receiving the book.
- 3. Students should not exchange school library books.
- 4. All should see that an atmosphere of silence and solemnness is maintained in the library at all times.
- 5. Books will not be issued during the vacations. At a time, only one book will be issued. A book may be retained only for one week, after which a fine of Rs.10.00 per week will be charged until it is returned or until it is re-issued.
- 6. Pupils from Std V onwards must read atleast 10 English and 10 other language books in a year. A two page summary of each book read must be shown to the librarian. The library records included in the diary should be maintained scrupulously

House System

To impart a healthy competitive spirit among students and to inculcate the habit of working together and enhancing leadership qualities, an efficient system of 'houses' has been introduced in the school. All the students belong to one 'house' or the other and are guided by a House Mistress (a teacher) assisted by a House Captain and House Vice Captain (all students.)

It is the responsibility of the house mistress to look after the general progress of her wards in curricular and co-curricular activities.

All arts and sports competitions are held house wise. So house loyalties are the strongest. A regular record of the pupil's participation and achievement in house activities is maintained and merit points are awarded to each house by a team of teachers.

Recommendations to the parents and guardians

Parent teacher meetings are organized on regular basis to find ways of assisting your wards in his/her academic and personal development.

You are requested

- 1. to attend all parent teacher meeting organised by the school.
- 2. to attend all programmes of the school to encourage your children.
- 3. to respond to all intimations sent to you from the school.

- 4. to notify the school of any change in your address as early as possible.
- 5. to intimate the Principal and the class teachers if there are some particulars or relevant information about the child.
- 6. to communicate with the authorities and find a solution to all the problems that arise.
- 7. to sign the report cards, examination papers and any other information sent from the school.
- 8. to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline by helping the children to have systematic learning.
- 9. to assist your wards in taking an active interest in the activities of the school.
- 10. to send only appropriate and healthy snacks and lunch. It is better if they are dry as far as possible especially till Std. IV.
- 11. to pay online tuition fees on or before 10^{th} of every month.
- 12. to make a note in the diary with your signature in the column provided with the reason for absence of the child for the class.
- 13. to see that your wards are using only pencils for writing till Std. IV. They are permitted to use fountain pens only from Std. V onwards.
- 14. to produce a medical certificate along with application for medical leave.
- 15. to be aware that your ward's name will be struck off if he/she is absent for more than a month without prior intimation.
- 16. to be aware that for KG children there won't be any formal exams. We shall conduct continuous assessment in the form of worksheets oral and written work.
- 17. to see that your ward wears the prescribed uniform including foot wear.
- $18. \ \ \, \text{to buy all text books only from the school store.}$
- 19. to encourage that all children should participate in all the academic and co-curricular activites of the school.
- 20. to be aware that any serious misconduct or objectionable behaviour of your ward will lead to the dismissal from the school.
- 21. to make good any loss or damage to the school property by the student.
- 22. to note that the school does not encourage private tuitions.
- 23. to communicate (requests, suggestions and complaints) only to the Principal/other authorities notified by the Management.
- 24. to make all request to the Principal at least one week in advance to obtain signatures on travel concession forms, bona fide certificates, reimbursement of fees etc.
- 25. to give proper identity of the escorts at the school front office to pick up their wards back home from the school. Escorts with proper identitiy only are allowed to pickup the wards.

- 26. to go through the diary of the students of the lower classes and assist the children in their learning.
- 27. to make full use of the free **extra coaching classes** extended to the **academically weak students before/after school** hours and/or on holidays. In such cases they **should make their own arrangements for conveyance**.
- 28. to encourage and inculcate in your wards the habit of speaking in English even outside the school campus.
- 29. to co-operate and support the institution which paves way for better teaching and learning.
- 30. to go through the above recommendations and help all to adhere to them.
- 31. not to send any bakery items as snacks. Only homemade food, vegetable and fruits are allowed.
- 32. to see that children bring only necessary books according to time table of school and they carry School Diary everyday

Please don't

- 1. Take the children home between school hours except on emergency cases.
- 2. Send children to school for at least for a fortnight if they are suffering from infectious diseases like chicken pox, measles, mumps etc. until they are medically fit.
- 3. Allow children to wear valuable materials like gold ornaments (the school is not in any way responsible for the loss or damage to the valuables brought to the school.)
- 4. Send soft drinks and other beverages to school.
- 5. Allow children to bring any other material that is not related to their learning to the shcool.
- 6. Visit the class rooms during the school hours.
- 7. Allow your wards to bring motorcycles, scooters and mobilephones to the school campus.

Guidelines to the students

The school expects the students:

- 1. to bring this diary to the class daily
- 2. to be punctual and regular in attendance. To develop the good virtue of punctuality ie to be on time to the school to the class, in submission of assignments, etc.
- 3. to maintain a high standard of general behaviour.
- 4. to be polite, friendly and well mannered in and outside the school.
- 5. to be obedient, respectful and courteous to your parents, elders and

teachers and always be truthful.

- 6. to bring umbrella on rainy days.
- 7. to wear correct school uniform to the school and to be neat and tidy.
- 8. to learn to keep your house, your school and your surroundings clean.
- 9. to be attentive in the class and to foster a love for reading.
- 10. to understand the value of silence in the class, in the library, in the lab and at the assembly. This helps in concentration and helps you and others to learn better.
- 11. to develop a sense of belonging to our school, to your house, our country and the universe.
- 12. to move in an orderly way in line one behind another while going from one place to another.
- 13. to keep always to the left while going up or coming down the staircase.
- 14. to inculcate respect for one's property as well as the school's and of others.
- 15. to take care of one's belongings like bags, books, money, clothes and other things brought to the school.
- 16. to speak in English in school to improve your communication English and maintain a suitable level of conversation.
- 17. to donate books to school library on any celebrations, especially on birthdays.
- 18. to keep the campus plastic free.
- 19. to cover the lunch box in towel.
- 20. Boys are expected to have short, neatly combed and evenly pruned hair which should never be long enough to touch the ears, eyebrows or the shirt collar. Side burns must not extend beyond middle of the ear on either side. Senior boys are expected to be clean shaven.
- 21. Girls should double plait their hair.
- 22. Students who are caught for possession of alcohol or any kind of narcotic substances, or theft / shop lifting, serious breach of conduct etc. will be expelled with immediate effect.
- 23. Not to loiter around shopping malls, bakeries, or coffee shops in school uniform after school hours.
- 24. Not to drive motorbikes/cars into the campus even on holidays.
- 25. The following disciplinary measures may be adopted by the school in dealing with students behaving in any unruly manner.
 - · Oral warning and counselling
 - Written warning
 - Suspension
 - · Rustication

Please avoid

- 1. Using bad language and slang
- 2. Damaging the school property. Carving, writing and scratching on the walls and furniture.
- 3. Playing in the classrooms, corridors, halls etc.
- 4. Leaving the school premises during the school hours without the permission of the Principal.
- 5. Entering other classes without the permission of the teachers concerned.
- 6. Wearing valuable articles like gold chains, bangles, anklets etc.
- 7. Bringing materials like unnecessary books, walkmans, cellular phones, CDs, USB, Memory Cards etc. to the school.
- 8. Bringing sharp implements like blades, knives etc.
- 9. Shoes during rainy days
- 10. Bringing, distributing and eating chewing gum in the school.
- 11. Giving presents to the members of the staff without the permision of the Principal.
- 12. Boys wearing ear rings to school.
- 13. Wearing of smart watches to School
- 14. Dyeing of hair for boys and girls.

The school reserves the right to add, delete or modify the rules and regulations contained herein, in part or full, based on the practical experiences gained out of their observations and implementation.
